Who Becomes an Exchange Student |

Each year the NOE staff selects a group of 10-12 of the most deserving English students to participate in the exchange program here in the United States. These students have successfully completed the 5-year English program and represent NOE's philosophy of a well-rounded life. Dubbed the "Dream Team," they spend a month experiencing an American Christian home in the states.

The mission of the NOE Exchange Program is to provide an opportunity for the students to: further develop their English, experience and gain a deeper understanding of American culture, and be exposed to a Christian family.

Becoming a Host Family |

Host families are key to the NOE Exchange Program experience. Students stay in the states for one month, typically the month of July. A Host Family provides; a place to stay in their home, meals, and occasional transportation to 4 or 5 group activity events. Most importantly, a Host Family opens their home and their lives to their student.
